

The Green Flag Award is presented to a NAWGJ 'unsung hero' who has made outstanding contributions to our organization, promotes professionalism, and demonstrates leadership. Awards are given at the state, regional, and national levels.

Award Process:

- Send your nomination to your State Judging Director by October 15 each year.
- The State Governing Board selects the winner from their state by November 15 and sends the State's selection to the Regional Judging Director.
- The Regional Governing Board selects the Regional winner from those submitted by December 15 and sends the Region's winner to the National Board of Directors.
- The National award is given every 4 years and selected from the previous Regional winners and is presented at the National Symposium.
